Accounts for 2012-13 have still not been examined - have not managed to make contact with Nigel Hosken and won't now do so until after Christmas.

We agreed to raise minileague fees to £5/£2 from January and originally said we would leave the WNL fees at £4/£1. It's now apparent that BOK and others are charging £5 for seniors for WNL so we will do the same, to be consistent.

BOK insisted on paying us £12 for half the CSC entry fees for our 2 firstaiders who helped out on the day.

Several more O-tops were sold at the CSC final. There are now only 12 left, in various sizes: ladies short sleeve - 2; ladies long sleeve - 4; unisex short sleeve - 2; basic (V-neck) - 4. I've had several enquiries from people wanting other sizes (including children's) so we should get some more tops in the New Year. Suggest we put an order form in the next Legend to gauge the interest. There are just 5 buffs left, so act fast if you want to replace yours!

Asked SWOA for support for Gill's UKCC2 course and First Aid course. They will grant £125 towards the UKCC2 course once the new course is available (the one Gill had entered for next April was cancelled) and £25 towards the First Aid course. There is a useful document on the SWOA website 'What does SWOA do' which outlines the various support they might be able to give. Katy Dyer told me SWOA had earlier decided not to support First Aid courses in future but she was going to lobby for this to continue, so it would seem that she has been successful.

No problem with spending £48 on Vectormap Local for Barnwood and Abbeymead.

Received the November issue of the Club Officials Newsletter from BOF - don't recall ever seeing one before so maybe they've been going into my spam folder. FC agreement is carried forward to 2014 but the new cover note for club public liability insurance won't be available until after Christmas. - they are debating on 14 Dec whether or not to increase indemnity cover from £5M to £10M. They suggested also that if you are a club which makes profits from 'trading' it might be worth looking at becoming a 'CASC' (Community Amateur Sports Club). The big draw seemed to be the ability to claim Gift Aid on donations, but as it's a rare year when we receive even double figures in donations I don't think it's worth the hassle! Pat Cameron suggested it a while ago as it seemed you could claim Gift Aid on subscriptions but that is explicitly excluded. Some scary-sounding stuff about liability for National Insurance and Income Tax of those doing work for you, but I don't think it applies to anything we do. It would have been helpful to give concrete examples of where such charges might apply.
