## Financial report for 1 September

Current account (includes deductions for o/s cheques, plus monies to be banked): £5410.83

So far have received Caddihoe money paid to Fabian4 up to end July (£448.38) so there's a lot more to come, plus some £1700 from the VHI entrants.

Deposit account: £3460.84

Plus about 60p interest end June.

Summer events: Thursdays (8) - Profit: £566.80; Saturdays (4) - Profit £168.50.

For comparison, profit on Informals (6) was £556.95; Minileagues (8) £2588.35; WNL (3) £238.70 Profit on minileagues the previous year was about £1550, but 2013/14 was the first full season with higher entry fees, and numbers were up too.

BOF/SWOA Levies paid up to and including 24 July (expect to have paid up to end August, including Chairman's Challenge, by time of meeting). We will do the levy/participation returns for VHI as well as the Caddihoe itself and bill VHI for their entries less the SWOA levy cost, which has been waived.

New order of O-tops: sterling cost was £935.77 (including £27.17 currency conversion!) for 23 zip-neck (mix of long and short sleeves) and 2 basic. Cost was about 10 euros more per shirt than last time but we will still charge the same subsidised rate of £30 for seniors, £20 for juniors. I paid via credit card as the simplest - I had some NGOC cash in hand and there will be enough from events in September to reimburse me for the remaining £600. New purchaser Judith Austerberry delighted with her new top!

#### Tasks in Progress

- Ongoing planning for Caddihoe Chase/VHI, September 2014. Entries as at first closing date 281, excluding VHI. Revenue for these £4495. Current cost estimate is about £5k, so after VHI entry fees(approx£1900) plus latecomeres we should be Ok financially.
- No particular issues, other than some concern over catering traders, and possible security exposures. I dont think the regular stalls, whom we have to use, can handle the volume, but my back-up O-Nosh have decided not to come as they made no money at the 2013 Caddihoe. I hope to persuade them to come on the grounds that our numbers will be significantly higher, and there are likely to be serious queues at the other stall. On security, am slightly concerned about leaving Day 2 assembly unattended Friday night and Saturday, and toilets in day Assembly on Day 2. have asked a competitor who is bring a campervan if they would consider camping at Day 2 Assembly!
